### DAY OF RECORDS

### Sunday October 10, 2010

The title of the biggest marathon in Australia is one that most race directors try to throw around increasingly these days as part of their promotional spin. But for this year, that honour clearly rests with the St.George Melbourne Marathon.

All events are riding the current running boom but Melbourne continued its rapid resurgence. In 2006, when IMG took ownership of the event, marathon entrants had fallen to 1770 and the overall field was just 7000. Those numbers quickly jumped up with the move to an MCG finish in 2007 and in 2010 the event boasted 5,650 marathon entrants and a record 28,396 overall with the capacity in some events reached six weeks prior to race day.

When race day came and the temperature was 11 degrees at 7am with not a breath of wind, it was obvious it was going to be a day of PBs.It was still 11 degrees at 8am when the half started, although once the early morning mist dissipated, the temperature rose gradually to around 24 degrees by 2pm. But by then 5,053 marathoners had completed the course making Melbourne the largest ever Australian marathon by finishers, eclipsing the 4,798 in the 1983 Melbourne race and the 4,778 in the Sydney 2000 Olympic trial marathon.

This years marathon saw two long standing race records broken. Kenyan Japhet Kipkorir won after finishing in 2hrs11min4sec, four seconds faster than the US legend Bill Rodgers recorded back in 1982. But his win came in vastly different circumstances. Rodgers, a four-time Boston marathon winner and legend of the sport was lucky enough to strike a rare tailwind on the old Frankston to Melbourne course.

Kipkorir, a cattle farmer (he has four cows) from Kapkoi, four hours drive from Nairobi, was recommended by Dan Hornery, an Australian runner, who had lived in Kenya. It became obvious when Kipkorir won a high-profile 30km cross country event in Sweden three weeks prior to the Marathon that the 29-year-old was in good form and would make things tough for Ethiopian Asnake Fekadu, who was returning to try and make it three wins in a row.

The women's winner was quite clear cut from the minute Ethiopian Mulu Seboka got off the plane from her home at Addis Ababa. Seboka, 27, is part of the Ethiopian national squad, which puts her regularly under the eye of distance legend Haile Gebrselassie, who told her two years ago to reduce her training workload which had reached 280km a week. She ran 2:28 to win the Toronto Marathon in 2008, has won the Mumbai Marathon three times and had turned up in Perth to win the City to Surf marathon on August 28. Seboka claimed the record after crossing the line in 2:32.20 and took 67 seconds off the record set by three-time Olympian Sue Hobson in 1999.

At 7am, when the gun was fired by football great Ron Barassi, a group of six charged away - four Africans (Kipkorir, Fekadu, Kenyans Cleophas Rop and Mossop Kemboi) plus two more Africans who are now based in Australia - Yared Temesgen and Gelata Wondwosen. They covered the first 5km in 16 minutes and were just a shade off race record pace but once they turned into the Albert Lake section, their pace picked up a little and they dropped Temesgen as they went through 10km in around 31.42. By this

stage they were around two minutes clear of the chasing Aussies - Scott McTaggart, Rowan Walker and Scott Rantall - who were tracking at around 2:17 pace. Amazingly at that point, tiny Seboka had moved up to 11th overall and was on 2:22 pace.

Kipkorir, wearing a beanie and gloves, had done almost all of the leading up front and was getting annoyed at the lack of support for pace-making duties so he stepped up the tempo to 3min pace and Kemboi departed at 12km. A succession of fast kilometres along Beaconsfield Parade saw the lead group reach 20km in 61.58. By the time he reached half way in 65.20 he had dropped Fekadu, then Rop and finally Wondwosen and, suddenly, Rodgers' race record was under threat.

"I felt great. The other guys they didn't want to lead so I knew I had to do it by myself," he later said. Kipkorir kept churning out kilometres at 3.05 pace along St Kilda Rd and the Tan. Even up the only significant hill on the course at the 35km mark, he slowed only marginally to 3:10 pace. Eventually with the MCG crowd in full cry he sprinted around the final 360m to just pip Rodgers' time.

Kipkorir's only other marathon was the Stockholm race in 2007 and his time then of 2:30 was influenced by blisters. He is not part of any mainstream Kenyan distance running program and as such has no plans to run another marathon and did not know who 'Boston Billy' Rodgers was initially, when asked. But he did indicate he would defend his title in 2011, "Yes I will come back ... if I get an invitation," he said.

Kipkorir wasn't the only one running fast with 223 runners breaking 3 hours including 13 females and nine men over the age of 50. Fekadu regrouped and ran home strongly for second, but it was the performance of Canberra's Walker that surprised. The 40-year-old won this race in 2007 in 2:19.16 and spent the first four months of this year in Afghanistan working for the Defence Department - hardly ideal for training. After being dropped by McTaggart soon after half way, he charged back past him late in the race and came home for third in 2:18.01 to record a PB at the age of 40 and win the Australian title. "You won't find too many Australian athletes running 2:18 at 40, except for Steve Moneghetti," Walker said. "The conditions were perfect and you'd have to say it's a fast course. There's a few turns but it's pretty flat and really interesting." McTaggart, better known as a mountain runner, couldn't quite catch a tiring Wondwosen, but still ran a PB aged 32 in 2:18.49.

First Victorian home in seventh place was Rantall, who was happy with 2:20.37, while Geelong's Colin Thornton moved through the field for eighth place in 2:25.04.

Former winner and event stalwart, Michael McIntyre, was the first 50 year old and 20th overall in 2:31.43. The battle for second place in the women's race proved a ripper with Kiwi Sarah Biss being passed by Sunshine Coast Pacific Lutheran College school teacher Roxie Fraser (nee Schmidt) at the 41km mark. Fraser claimed second in 2:43.52 and her Australian title win – not bad for someone who wasn't going to enter until two weeks prior to the race. "I've had tendonitis so I didn't think I'd do the race.



I really just turned up because my twin sister Cassie, who lives in Melbourne, was going in it," she said. "I caught Sarah at 41km and I fet really bad passing her."

Next home 2.52.00 was Adelaide's Sam Boag, a 40-year-old mum of the started running three years ago. "I had an awesome run as a PB by six minutes. I can quit now as I'm too old for the started running three years ago."

Special thanks also to the MCC, Athletics Australia, City of Melbourne, VicRoads, the Victoria Police and all the authorities for their support; without which this event could not happen.

We are proud to showcase Melbourne to the world and thank you for being part of this iconic "Melbourne event". We hope to see you all again next October.






